

# Navigating Business Registration in Nigeria

## CAC Registration Toolkit: Step-by-Step Business Setup Checklist

This checklist toolkit is designed to guide you through the process of registering a business in Nigeria via the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC) portal. By following these steps, you can ensure that you complete every stage correctly and avoid unnecessary delays.

### 1. CAC Account Setup Toolkit

Before you begin the business registration process, you need to create an account on the CAC Company Registration Portal (iCRP).

#### Account Setup Checklist

- Visit the CAC portal: [services.cac.gov.ng](https://services.cac.gov.ng)
- Click **Create Account**
- Enter your email address and phone number
- Create a secure password
- Verify your email address
- Enable Two-Factor Authentication (2FA)
- Log in to access your CAC dashboard

With your account active, you can start the business name reservation process.

### 2. Business Name Reservation Toolkit

The first official step in registering a business in Nigeria is reserving a unique business name.

#### Name Reservation Checklist

- Log in to your [CAC dashboard](#)
- Click **Name Reservation**
- Select **Business Classification**
- Choose **Business Type** (e.g., Sole Proprietorship)
- Enter your proposed business name

- Select the nature of business
- Click **Check Availability**
- If available, proceed to payment
- Receive your Availability Code (AV Code)

Your AV Code is necessary to continue the registration process.

### 3. Business Name Registration Toolkit

Once your name reservation is approved, you can complete the business name registration process.

#### Registration Checklist

- Log in to your CAC dashboard
- Click **Registration**
- Select **Register New Business**
- Enter your AV Code
- Enter your business email address
- Enter the business address
- Enter the date of business commencement

### 4. Proprietor Information Toolkit

During registration, CAC requires information about the business owner.

#### Proprietor Details Checklist

- Enter the proprietor's full name
- Enter date of birth
- Enter nationality
- Enter occupation
- Enter residential address

#### Document Upload Checklist

- Means of identification (NIN, Passport, Voter Card, etc.)
- Passport photograph
- Signature sample

Click **Add Proprietor Document** to upload and save each document.

### 5. Application Review Toolkit

Before submitting your registration application, carefully review all information.

#### Application Review Checklist

- Confirm business name spelling
- Confirm proprietor information is correct
- Confirm uploaded documents are clear
- Confirm business address is accurate
- Review details on the Preview Page

If everything is accurate, proceed to payment.

## 6. Payment and Submission Toolkit

After completing the form, the final step is submitting the application.

### Submission Checklist

- Click **Proceed to Payment**
- Pay through Remita
- Confirm payment success
- Submit application

Once submitted, the system will process your application.

## 7. Registration Status Toolkit

You can track your application progress from your CAC dashboard.

### Status Monitoring Checklist

- Log in to the CAC portal
- Open your application dashboard
- Check the status of your application

Possible statuses include:

- **Pending** – Application under review
- **Queried** – CAC requests corrections
- **Approved** – Registration completed

If approved, you can download your certificate.

## 8. Certificate Download Toolkit

Once your registration is approved, you will receive your official CAC documents.

### Certificate Download Checklist

- Log in to your CAC dashboard
- Click **Action → Approved Application**
- Download **Certificate of Registration**
- Download **Status Report**

These documents confirm that your business is legally registered in Nigeria.
